Students who have not met their financial obligations will have the following withheld:

Seniors who have not met all of their financial obligations will not receive their cap and gown or be allowed to participate in commencement exercises.

A \$25.00 late fee will be assessed if payment for student fees, bus fees or athletic fees is not received by the due date.

A \$25.00 fee will be assessed for returned checks or denied credit card charges.

Scholarships/Waivers/Work Equity

1. Required fees, cost of textbooks, and busing fee may be waived for families receiving public aid, students who are a ward of the State, or families experiencing financial hardship. Documentation and application is required prior to paying for fees and purchasing textbooks. Contact the Business Office for further information. (847-604-7457)
2. A Work Equity Program is available for qualified students unable to pay the Athletic Participation Fee. Guidelines and applications are available in the Business Office.

Student eligibility is primarily determined by membership in a family whose annual income falls below the following guidelines as per the 2010 Federal 1040 Tax form (must be presented):

* These figures were obtained from the 2011 Lower Living Standard Income Levels provided by the Secretary of Labor published on 3/21/11.

To determine income levels for families with more than six dependents, take the amount of increase in the allowance from five to six dependents and apply that increment to each dependent over six.
